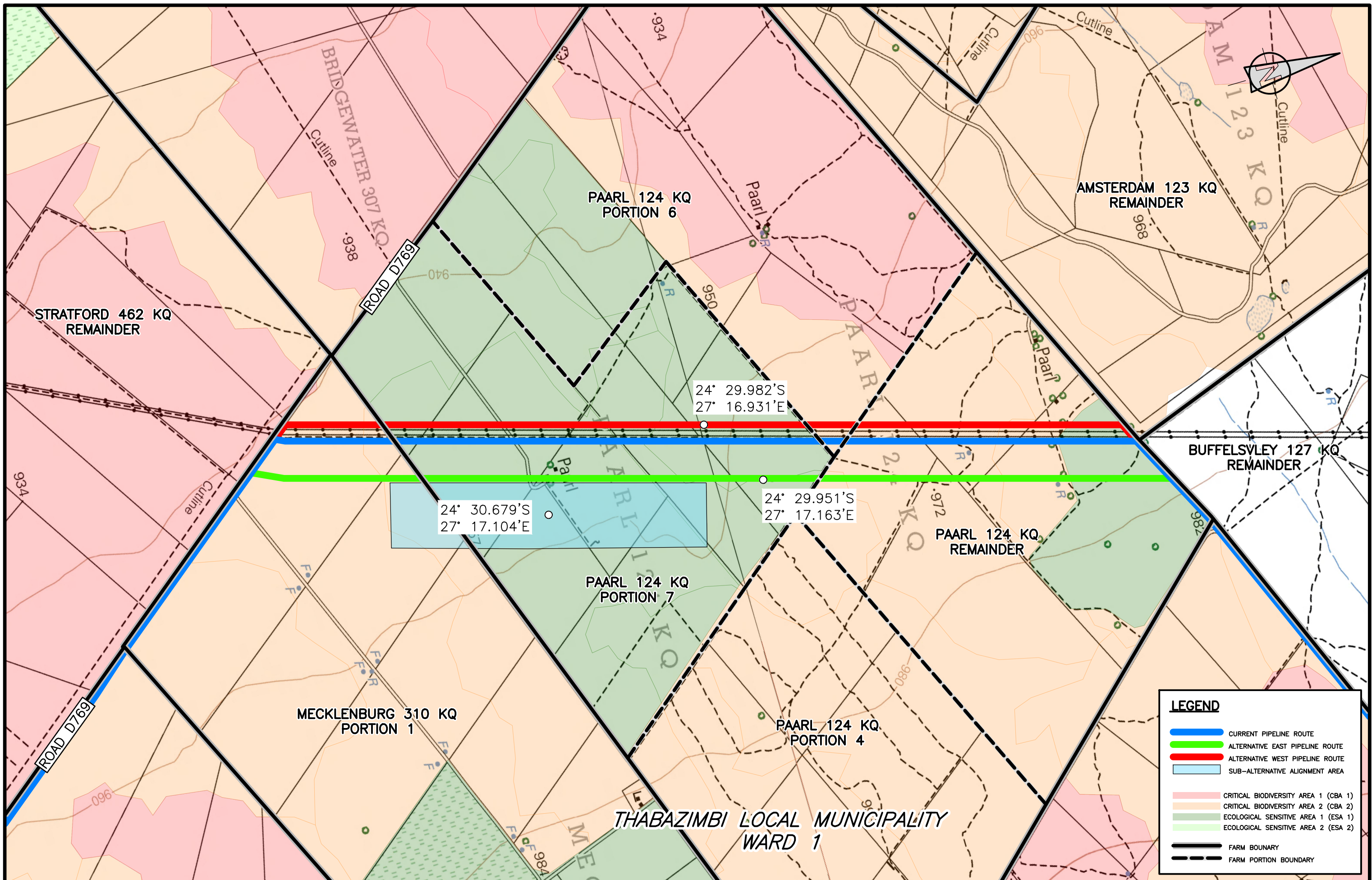

He advised that different options should be considered.
